All items will be judged by the Danish System of judging: Judged on the quality of work you have put into making it and not compared to other entries.

Awards are given for acceptable work:

- A. Blue Ribbon Group \$5.00
- B. Red Ribbon Group \$3.00
- C. White Ribbon Group \$1.00
- D. Participant Ribbon no premium earned

GRAND CHAMPION

Awarded to the Cloverleaf, Junior, and Senior 4-H'er who meets the minimum standards and earns the most Blue Ribbons. A \$25 premium is awarded to the qualified champions. A minimum of ten entries to be considered for Grand Champion?

- > All exhibits must meet quality standards to be considered for premium money.
- Canning items: standard canning jars required; properly sealed lids; clean (not sticky) exterior. Others will be **disqualified**.

A 4-H member can enter only one item for each number listed.

Items will be properly displayed, judged, and cared for; further than this, responsibility ceases.

ALL items MUST be made by the 4-H'er since September of 2021.

Items judged to be above the skill level of the youth may be disqualified.
